The following list of publications by members of the faculty of The University of Texas is based on materials supplied by each member of the faculty of The University of Texas, both Main and Medical Branch. It should contain all work actually published during the calendar year 1939, except newspaper items. This list is mimeographed on an experimental basis in order that we may consider whether it is desirable to print such a list annually. The list for 1939 has been compiled in the Office of the Dean of the Graduate School without faculty editorship, and each item has been presented as the author reported it. An effort has been made to have one member of each department check the publications of all the members of that department. Every member of the General Faculty and every member of the Medical Faculty was asked to report his publications. An incomplete effort was made to get publications from members of the staff who are not members of the faculty. The experience of compiling the present list shows that future publication of such a list should be in charge of an editorial committee of faculty members, with definite rules about bibliographical form and materials to be included.
