Harriman can receive him anytime, the Secretary of State will also be available with the possibility that he will be away from the city between 11-13 January and The President is most grateful for the spirit that lies behind all their efforts. The Romanian Ambassador was also informed that The President was in Texas and we did not know when he will return and that he has a lot of pressing problems on his hands.
