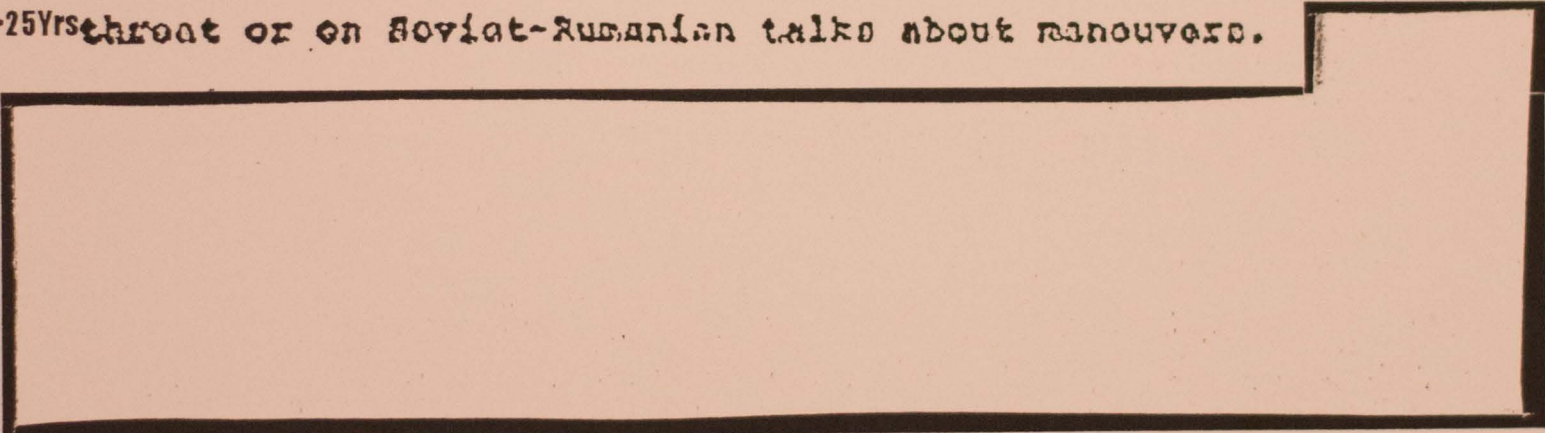

INTELLIGENCE MEMORANDUM

SUBJECT: The Rumanian situation as of 1200 GMT

1. The political and military situation in Rumania continues to be quiescent. Rumanian officials and diplomats around the world still project a calm outlook. The Rumanian Ambassador to Washington, Corneliu Bogdan, calmly said yesterday that he was aware of rumors, but he had no recent information on an invasion threat or on Soviet-Rumanian talks about manouvers.
