IMPORTS FROM CHINA

The Board of Trade announce that as from 13th November, 1941 applicants for licences to import goods consigned from China will be required to complete an undertaking that payment for those imports will be made through a bank in China approved by the Exchange Control Authorities for this purpose and that payment will be made within a specified period. They will also be required to submit to the Import Licensing Department from time to time returns specifying the goods imported under the licence and the remittances made in payment thereof.
