Each summer the University Council on Research awards a number of summer fellowships to faculty members. These awards are distinct from the Council's summer subsistence grants in that they pay somewhat larger stipends. The applications are competitive with the winners selected by a faculty committee.

For 1968 the Council has made the stipend pattern to be the same for all recipients: \$2000, except that in no case may it exceed the recipient's normal summer salary. If it is desirable mutually to the department and the recipient, the stipend may be supplemented by one-third time summer teaching at the University except that the total pay allowed will not be more than the recipient's regular summer salary.

Applications should describe briefly (say, one or two pages) the work planned for the summer and should have the approval of the department head. A Vita of the applicant should be attached.

All applications to be considered for the Summer 1968 must be received by December 12, 1967.
