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Dear Dr. Stenzel, I enclose a report that I hope may be of some interest to you. You will see from reading the paper that we should like to get our hands on argonitic shell material of Tertiary nautilus. I wonder if you can help us in this respect, since you have worked with this group. We can work with quite small quantities of material, appreciable less than a gram, which could be scraped off a specimen without causing perceptible damage. We should be most grateful either if you could help us directly or put us in touch with someone who can.
