(1) Arcostrea Carinata Lamark slab. The Ostrea Travisana is an Aff. to regular Ostrea Travisana & much smaller variety.

If these are of any help to you let me know, if you want more are other kinds as I listed let me know. Have you ever seen the small spines that accompany Echinoids of the Phymosoma Texana & others of this locality. These spines might interest you for study.

Would you kindly let me know if there is any Eocene beds of fossils in the Flynn area. Also you might know of Miocene beds near the coast I might work. In exchange for this info. I might be able to give more material for study for same. I am acquainted with the Stone City Beds & your book. But I would like to trade for fossils of any kind I do not have are for information about localities.
