Dear Mr. Stenzel:

We are sending you, under separate cover, a quantity of Mercenaria mercenaria larvae approximately seven days old. They are about 200 μ long, which is within their setting-size range; however, these larvae were still swimming. They have been killed, soaked and rinsed in fresh water and oven-dried at 30-40°C. I hope they are satisfactory.

Do you still want post-set individuals? We can supply them but it will take a while because we have no excess at the moment.
