In response to your letter of October 11, please look up the A.A.P.G. Bulletin, volume 24, no. 9, pages 1663 to 1667, and University of Texas Publication 3948, plate 51 opposite page 862. In these two publications, you will find my style of section description and drawing. Perhaps you can gradually learn to do it in a similar way.

For your use in field work of that type, you should have a hand level, a steel carpenter's tape of the type that costs approximately 80¢, and a good notebook. I use a metal notebook cover going under the trade name "Stay-Open Holder", stock no. 7706, standard B & P Loose Leaf, holding 8½ x 8½" loose sheets.
