Dear Dr. Mayr:

Please find enclosed manuscript of "Successional Specialisation in Palaeontology" for publication in the journal Evolution. I have followed the directions for preparation of the manuscript rather carefully except that some of the figures, if reduced according to notations given, will be more than  $6\frac{1}{2}$  inches long or  $4\frac{1}{8}$  inches wide. I notice that the normal text page is nearly 8 inches long; hence it should be possible to accommodate the figures at the sizes which I planned for them. As indicated in red pencil, figures 1 and 2 are best printed on opposite pages facing each other, preferably on the second and third pages of the article. I hope these features will meet with your approval.
