I want to thank you for your kind reply of November 19th, concerning crabs of the Cook Mountain. If you could find that a little specimen from Moseley's Ferry without that it inconveniences you too much, I would be highly pleased to have it for description.

Your idea of correlating the coastal plain sediments with the diastrophism in the cordilleran region, is, I think, the only basis for such work.
