Dear Bob:

Herewith are facsimile copies of corrected figures for rudists with accompanying check list calling attention to sub figure numbers involved in changes. I think that this will facilitate your review. I am surprised to see how many changes have been called for and the extremely great improvements which your study has yielded. Please let us know promptly of any further difficulties which you may encounter.

For some weeks now, we have been waiting to go ahead with page proofs for Bivalvia except for lack of rudists and oysters. We will begin typesetting as soon as the necessary typescripts are available -- doubtless first from you, and I hope before too long from Henryk Stenzel.

I am now leaving for the journey to Britain to pick up the Wollaston Medal and for a few Treatise conferences. I will be back in Lawrence by 7 May 1968 and earnestly hope that you are able to have the remainder of rudists materials in my hands by that date. I will give immediate attention then in shaping it for the Press.
