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Dear Ray:

Thank you for your letter of 17 February, 1970, and its enclosures. The prompt attention you gave to the Chondrodontidae and to some of the questions raised by me is greatly appreciated.

Your outline of how figure labels and descriptions of individual figures are to be handled has my approval. Mrs. McCormick has done a fine piece of preparing the sample on Gryphaea. She should continue doing the same for all the other figures pertaining to systematic Descriptions. It is quite a chore and her help is most welcome.

I have rechecked the 4 ms. pages on Chondrodontidae and have found only one error. On p. 3 on line 11 from top, at end of paragraph write (Douville, 1902) and not Douville.

I believe the reference to Douville, 1902, on p. 2, line 4 from top, and the reference to Stanton, 1947, on same page, line 7 from top, and to Pease, 1871, on p. 3, line 4 from bottom are objectionable because they are out of style. The full references belong under "References", and in the text there should be only "DOUVILLE (1902, p. 317)" and "STANTON (1947, p. 48)" and "PEASE (1871, p. 46)".

This brings us to the "References" pertaining to the Chondrodontidae. Where are they to go?
