I have been authorized to offer you the position of Assistant Professor of Geology at the University of Houston for the academic year 1956-1957 at a salary of \$600.00 per month for the nine months' period. The fall semester begins the first week in September.

The University of Houston is a member of the Texas State Teachers' Retirement System, for which an amount not to exceed \$180 is deductible annually. This amount is matched by the State; and if a teacher leaves the State of Texas or retires from the profession his contributions, together with interest, are returnable at his request. The University of Houston has also elected to accept the provisions of the United States Social Security program.
