My dear Stenzel:

As our program for December 15 develops, it has seemed desirable to put in a symposium on major unconformities in the Texas geologic section. Under this head we hope to discuss some of the larger breaks and periods of folding. As you know we had thought originally that we would make up a program entirely from non-Bureau members. For this discussion, however, it does not seem that anyone is available to discuss breaks in pre-Cambrian except possibly Baker and yourself. I am wondering, therefore, if you would be willing to give a brief statement, say five or ten minutes, or less if you like, as to pre-Cambrian conditions in the Llano region. We shall expect a discussion of breaks in the pre-Cambrian probably to occupy less time than breaks in the other systems but if you will undertake to say something about the Llano region it will help out very much. I shall be able to send you a preliminary program within a few days. On this preliminary program we are not listing the names of those who are to participate in the discussion on unconformities because the list is not yet complete.

I trust that your work is proceeding satisfactorily although I imagine you have had some rains within the past week.
