I was interested to learn that you were about to write the chapter on Ostreidae in the volume on Bivalvia in the Treatise on Invertebrate Palaeontology. less

My main interest in Gryphaea has been centered upon its systematic treatment than upon the light its story throws upon evolutionary principles. I am enclosing herewith copies of such of my articles as have survived the lapse of time, which I happen to have in my possession; and hope that you may find some items of information that may be of use to you. In my retirement I am working on a collection I made some years ago of Gryphaes from the Lower Lias of Leicestershire. I doubt whether this will be completed in time to be of use to you.

I regret I have had no opportunity to examine specimens of Karnian and Norian Gryphaeas found elsewhere than in Britain. I hope sometime to see whether there is such material in the British Museum. Unfortunately I am not as mobile as I used to be.
