Dear Stenzel —

I have been looking for that beak like thing that we decided was a piece of barnacle but have not been able to locate it. I do have 2 of the flat plate like pieces.

I have run across the following in regard to some of the molluscs:

Corbula texana, ²⁸⁰⁰ according to Heilprin comes from Smithville and Gabb's outline does suggest Corbula smithvillensis Harris.

Turris moorei Gabb is stated to have nodes on the early whorls. I have a species from Little Brazos resembling the thing I have been calling T. moorei having the nodes. The one that is most common has no nodes on the early whorls.
