
Dear Dr. Stenzel:

Many thanks for your kind letter and for going over the fossil section of my paper. I particularly like your suggestion of adding a statement to the effect that if the anatomy of Terebrimya were known it probably would be different from that of any living form.

The editor has gone over the manuscript and I am now checking the corrections and adding the data which I got while in India. Saw all of the types of Nair and Rajagopal, and know that those of Daniel are lost so can make definite statements on these. Also saw the soft parts of Uperotus so can place the genus with certainty. This was the only one, except Zachia, which I had not seen. Zachia was described from Siberia and I don't expect to see any of them in a hurry.
