Your three papers, two from Bureau publications and one reprint from "Science," arrived this morning. I certainly appreciate receiving these bulletins, and I hope in the future that you will continue to think so kindly of me as to keep me on your mailing list.

I note that your paper on the Ball clay of the Troup district contains some remarks on the Carrizo in which I am still interested. I have not forgotten that you once offered to review any additional work that I might carry out on the Carrizo, and I still hope some day to have time to draw up some detailed subsurface sections and show a little more clearly than we now are able to what some of the relationships of this formation are in the south Texas area. I am enclosing a copy of a little summary that I got up sometime ago on the stratigraphic position of the Carrizo. You probably have a much more extensive file on this than I do, but here is a copy for whatever use you care to make of it.

I hope to be in Austin sometime during the fall to continue work on the samples I have been examining at the Well Sample Library, and I will certainly attempt to drop by for a visit with you while I am in town.
