I am working here in Texas on the Tertiary and find that I need as much comparative material from outside of Texas as I can possibly obtain. If you need in your work Tertiary fossils (topotypes), I could send you material from nearly all the Gulf states.

I have made a partial list of fossil localities in South Carolina in which I am particularly interested. If you can help me in any way, I would appreciate it greatly.
