Do you agree that it is <u>ai</u>? I cannot see at a quick glance an exact parallel, but I think I'm right in saying KN <u>du</u> never has more than two 'horns' above the horizontal line.

I am making preliminary doundings for my suggested project of photographing all the KN material (mentioned at Pavia). I hope you won't think this is cutting you out, or any criticism of your own small scale photos. I still hope you will edit the definitive publication; but this is a necessary preliminary, and can be done by others.
