LICENSING OF WHOLESALE FISH MERCHANTS IN
NORTHERN IRELAND

An order will shortly be made by the Minister of Food extending the Fish Sales (Control) Order, 1941, to Northern Ireland. The effect of this will be to prohibit from March 14th the sale of fish (except herrings) by wholesalers in Northern Ireland except under licence.

A sale to a fish frier is, for the purposes of the Order, a sale by wholesale.

The Order does not apply to any first-hand sale of fish, i.e. a sale by the producer.

Traders can obtain forms of application for licences from the Secretary, Ministry of Commerce, Chichester Place, Belfast.
