Last night a small number of enemy aircraft were over Eastern and North Eastern England, mainly in coastal districts. One raider, however, flew inland some distance towards the North West.

Bombs were dropped at several points. The number of casualties was not large but some people lost their lives. Some damage was caused, principally to houses in two coastal towns, but nowhere was it extensive.
