COST OF LIVING FIGURES FOR 1st JUNE

At 1st June the official cost-of-living index figure was 99 points above the level of July, 1914, as compared with 100 points at 1st May. For food alone the index figure was 59 points above the level of July, 1914, as compared with 60 points at 1st May, the decline being due to reductions in the price of milk in many districts.
