SULPHATE OF AMMONIA
Early Order Allowance for Farmers

To encourage farmers to order sulphate of ammonia early and so avoid delays next spring, the Government will grant a special allowance of 28s. per ton on orders over 2 cwt. if booked during July but as was the case last year, this offer will be withdrawn as soon as the supplies earmarked for this purpose have been booked.

When ordering, the farmer must say whether he wishes to take delivery at his nearest railway station or his farm or to collect ex store, and he must take delivery at the place named when the suppliers can deliver.

The monthly prices of sulphate of ammonia, before deducting the 28s. allowance, will be the same as last year, beginning at £9. 10s. 0d. per ton for minimum 6-ton deliveries and increasing by 1/6d. per ton each month until the maximum of £10. 2s. 0d. is reached for the period March to June.
