POLISH EXECUTIONS

The notorious German concentration camp at Oswiecim in Poland has become a mass graveyard for the Poles.

According to the latest reports received by the Polish Government in London, large transports of Polish prisoners continue to pour into the concentration camp. On January 16, three such transports arrived at Oswiecim, consisting of 5,000 people. On January 25, a further 4,000 were brought in.

Daily mass executions are continually being carried out in this infamous camp. Not less than 250 people are the daily victims of executions, and death from inhuman treatment, hunger and epidemics. There are six crematoria now installed in this murder-camp.

60 Polish miners from the Upper Silesian coal-mines at Breszcz accused of sabotage by slowing down their output, were brought to Oswiecim and shot in batches of ten each day between January 10 and 17.
