EXTENSION OF THE SPECIAL CHEESE RATION

The special cheese ration has now been made available to two additional categories of workers who are unable to take their mid-day meal at home and for whom the provision of canteen facilities is impracticable. They are:

- (a) Dry-stone dykers regularly employed on drystone dykeing who are not otherwise eligible for the cheese ration, e.g., by holding unemployment insurance cards stamped "agriculture".
- (b) Workers employed by the Ministry of War Transport Agency Services in isolated districts who have no access to canteens or catering facilities.

The special ration will also in future be available for all electrical linesmen and linesmen's mates employed on overhead construction work in open country, and not as hitherto only to such workers employed by the Central Electricity Board.

Application forms for the special cheese ration are obtainable from Local Food Offices.
