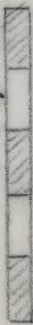

I intend in the near future to go through the lot - for the good of the museum nearly in the hope of getting more information about what he gave us. ~~B~~ Something may emerge.

The Patirikastro sherd is from the BIA excavations. It probably entered the museum in 1905 with much other stuff from the same dig. Owing to AE. numbers up to 1500 are of objects received 1896-1908. AE, by the way, means Aegean, not A Evans, as most would think.

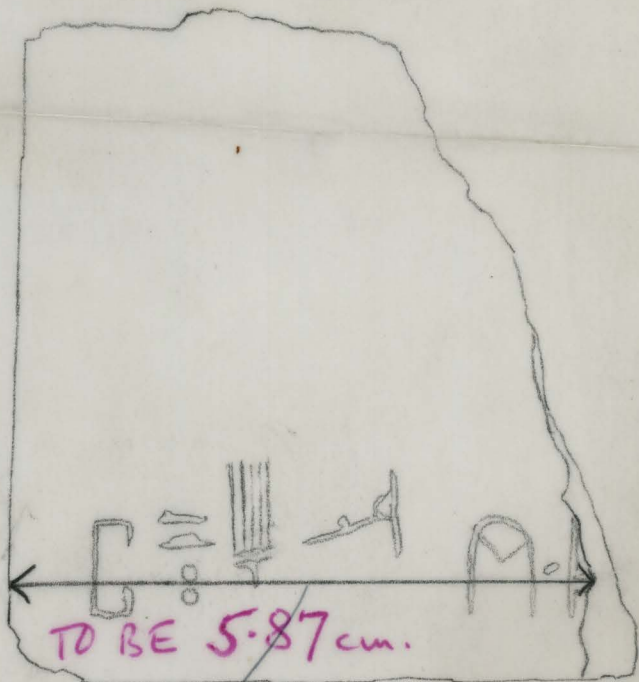
Scale indication for reduced
