Student Government Assembly Meeting, *April 11, 2017*

Start of the Meeting

The meeting was called to order at 7:05PM by the Speaker of the Assembly, Madison Huerta. First roll call is taken. There are no guests at this meeting and no students present to speak at open forum. There are no appointments.

Legislation

New Business:

- **A.R. 1** - In Support of H.B. 1938, Creating an Opt-Out Organ Donation Policy. The legislation is introduced. The purpose of the resolution is to show the students support for the Texas House Bill creating an Opt-Out Organ Donor policy. *Referred to the Student Affairs Committee.*
- **A.R. 3** - In Support of Implementing a System to Display All Declared Minors and Certificates on Transcripts. The legislation is introduced. The purpose is to ensure students are represented accurately through official university statements. *Referred to the Academic Affairs Committee.*
- **A.R. 4** - In Support of Eliminating Guessing Penalty Grading Policies in “Flipped” Classes. The legislation is introduced. The purpose is to show student opposition to the guessing penalty used on homeworks in many science and math courses. *Referred to the Academic Affairs Committee.*
- **A.R. 5** - A Resolution Recognizing Margaret C. Berry. The legislation is introduced. The purpose is to honor a recently deceased alumnae that drastically impacted the University. A fast-track is requested in order to send the Resolution to her family in a timely manner. *The Fast-Track is approved.*
- **A.R. 6** - In Support of the Energy Olympiad Competition. The legislation is introduced. The purpose is to show student support for the energy olympiad competition on campus. A motion is approved to table A.R. 6. *Tabled indefinitely.*
