Dear Dr Bennett,

This is a Linear B Week!

Yesterday Ventris was in Cambridge telling the Philological Society about his and Chadwick's work on the problem of decipherment; & today I receive your admirable Index. It really is most generous of you to send me this. I wish I had done something in this field of research to deserve it.

I am delighted to hear from Professor Wace that your publication of our Mycenaean tablets is well

advanced, & am looking forward to seeing it.

I hope to send you in a day or two the photos of the pons blocks, found by the Treasury of Atræas, with "mason's marks"; but I have not yet been able to identify them with certainty among Prof. Wace's negatives which I have here. As he should be in Cambridge in 3 days' time I think I'll wait and confirm that I have found the ones he meant before I send them off.

If there should be any other thing of this sort in which I can be of assistance I hope you will let me know.
