

OFFICIAL ADMIRALTY COMMUNIQUE

The Board of Admiralty regret to announce that H.M. Submarine SAHIB (Lieut J.H. Bronage, D.S.O., D.S.C, R.N.) has been sunk in the Central Mediterranean.

The next of kin of personnel have been informed.

According to enemy reports, the Commanding Officer, five other officers and forty one members of the crew were rescued and have been made prisoner-of-war.
