RELAXATION OF CENTRAL HEATING PROHIBITION

The Minister of Fuel & Power has given a permit under the Central Heating and Hot Water Plant General Direction relaxing the prohibition on the use of central plants for heating premises as from to-day in England and Wales and as from Saturday (when the prohibition would otherwise have come into effect) in Scotland until the permit is revoked.

The use of fuel for stoking central plants between 9.30 p.m. and 6 a.m. is still prohibited.
