M.P.s TO VISIT CANADA

In order to obtain a brief picture of the part being played by the Canadian Army, five Parliamentary Members from the House of Lords and House of Commons met Lieut.-Gen. G.L. McNaughton, GOC-in-C, First Canadian Army at his Headquarters recently. After their discussion they saw for themselves a small part of the Canadian Army in training.

They had already visited war workers and war factories in Britain, and will leave shortly for Canada to be guests of the Canadian Branch of the Empire Parliamentary Association.

In Canada they will meet the Prime Minister and see for themselves the Navy, the Army and the Air Force as well as Canadian war industries.

After their tour they are to hold a conference to discuss the total war effort being carried on throughout the Empire.

With the British delegates who include Lord Stansgate, Lord Marchwood, Sir Percy Harris and Mr. R.C. Morrison, will be representatives from New Zealand and Australia, and their discussions will be held with Canadian Members of Parliament in the Dominion.
