AIR MINISTRY COMMUNIQUE

This morning Typhoon bombers escorted by fighters attacked the airfield at Cherbourg/Maupertus.

This afternoon Typhoons bombed the power station at Caen. Later Mitchells of the R.A.F. and the Royal Dutch Naval Air Service bombed the airfield at Brest/Lanvecc.

Squadrons of Spitfires and Typhoons escorted and covered the bombers. Other Spitfires made supporting sweeps over a wide area.

From these operations six of our aircraft including two medium bombers are missing but the crew of one bomber is safe.
