ALLIES REACH THE VOLTURNO

October 6

Allied troops have reached the Volturno. The river, which is about 100 feet wide and a little over 6 feet deep, has steep banks to allow for heavy winter rains.

All bridges are blown either by the enemy or destroyed by our bombing. The Germans pulled out of the north river yesterday and pushing on against demolitions, our troops reached it during the day.
