THE 1943 ONION CROP

The Onion crop has turned out to be a very good one, and the Ministry of Food has been able to supply more onions than was anticipated to the large urban industrial areas.

In most areas the retailer will no longer mark the ration book when selling onions but he should still do so in the interests of equitable distribution in those areas in which there is still an intensive demand for a second lb. per ration book or there is a local shortage for any other reason.
