DIRECTOR GENERAL OF ARMY EDUCATION

The War Office makes the following announcement.

In view of the ever growing importance of education in the Army and the part it will play during the demobilization period, it has been decided to strengthen and unify the War Office directorates dealing with Education in the Army and A.B.C.A. by the appointment of a Director-General of Army Education to direct and co-ordinate the work done in those directorates.

Mr. P.R. Morris, the Director of Education for the County of Kent, who is being released for the purpose by the Kent County Council, has been appointed to this new post and will take up his duties early in February.
