CULTIVATION OF CANARY SEED

In order to ensure that the best use is made of all land suitable for the growing of essential food and feeding stuffs it has been decided to restrict the cultivation of canary seed, the acreage of which has been expanding in some areas, and for this purpose the Buckwheat (Control of Cultivation) Order, 1943, has been amended to include canary seed. As from 15th December no person with more than 10 acres of land may grow buckwheat or canary seed without first obtaining the written consent of his County War Agricultural Executive Committee.
