PRICE CONTROL OF SWEDES, TURNIPS, BEETROOT
AND PARSNIPS

The Minister of Food has made an Order amending the Root Vegetables (Maximum Prices) Order, 1943.

The amending Order prescribes maximum retail prices for swedes, turnips, beetroot and parsnips, to take effect as from the end of the price tables in the original Order.

The maximum retail prices are :-

In other respects, the Order remains unchanged. As previously announced, it applies only to crops sown in 1943.
