

NINTH AIR FORCE FIGHTER-BOMBERS STRIKE AT AIRFIELDS IN FRANCE

Thunderbolt fighter-bombers of the U.S. Ninth Air Force, escorted by other Ninth Air Force Thunderbolts, made a series of bombing and strafing attacks on several enemy airfields in Northern France this morning and this afternoon. None of our aircraft is missing.

Hangars, fuel dumps, flak-towers, barracks, administration buildings and dispersal areas were among the objectives crews reported hitting with bombs and machine-gun fire.

Capt. David Harmon, Walsh, Ill., dropped his bombs, then tore into a flak tower which was firing on the Thunderbolts.

"It was really throwing the stuff up," he said, "and I think I got it. Maybe that will settle some old scores."
