JOINT ANNOUNCEMENT BY THE AGRICULTURAL DEPARTMENTS AND THE MINISTRY OF FOOD

PRICES OF DREDGE CORN GROWN IN 1944

Prices for wheat, rye, barley and oats of the 1944 crops have already been announced. Details of the market prices for dredge corn, on a sale by a grower, are now announced as under:-

Millable Barley Dredge Corn (i.e. dredge corn consisting to the extent of two-thirds or more, by weight, of barley).

Maximum price 25s. Od. per cwt; minimum price 17s.6d. per cwt.

Other Millable Dredge Corn (i.e. dredge corn containing more than 25 per cent, by weight, of wheat and/or rye).

Maximum price 13s.6d. per cwt., or the price of millable wheat for the appropriate month, whichever is the higher; minimum price 13s.Od. per cwt.

The maximum price for non-millable dredge corn is 13s.6d. per cwt. and there is no minimum price.

Dredge Corn consisting solely of a Mixture of Pulses

A maximum price of 22s.Od. per cwt. has been introduced for mixed pulses of the 1944 crop, consisting entirely of either beans and peas, or one or both of them mixed with tares. There is no minimum price for this crop.
