CANADIAN PILOTS SHOOT UP AIRCRAFT ON GROUND

Two R.C.A.F. Mosquito pilots of the City of Edmonton Squadron this evening left two F.W.190s in flames in Northern France and damaged other enemy aircraft.

The two pilots found the F.W.'s and other aircraft on the ground at Toul, near Nancy. F/O Bert Ford of Lacombe, Alberta, went in first and opened fire, F/O T.N. Miller of Edmonton, sweeping in after him. As they broke away both F.W.'s were aflame and the pilots' gunfire had damaged other machines.
