TELL THE POLICE

The Air Ministry announces:- The public are reminded that any civilian who sees an enemy aircraft land in this country, whether it is damaged or not, is asked immediately to inform the police.

Enemy aircraft which fall into our hands may, when examined by technical experts, provide valuable information. It is important, therefore, that they should not be interfered with, that parts should under no circumstances be taken away as souvenirs, and that everything should be left for expert investigation precisely as found after the aircraft landed or crashed.
