Just received is your letter to me dated 17 February 1970 along with what you termed "the second batch" of references on oysters. It is important for me to know if "second batch" means last batch, because we cannot continue indefinitely efforts to add entries to the list.

I think that we can proceed in the manner you suggest for getting new materials set in type for galleys. Meanwhile, we have requested revised proofs of materials already set in type. I think that it will not be too difficult to guide the printers in making an overall integrated list. The fact that we proceeded long ago in typesetting oyster references which you had submitted, we cannot afford to undo this and will have to proceed with insertions of additions in simplest way possible.
