One differonce between the first world war and the second world war Is an extra $16,000,000$ miles of wire in the Post Office telephonc and telegraph systom in this country.

During the first war there were about $3,000,000$ miles: now there are roughly $19,000,000$.

Moro than $17,000,000$ milos of this wirc is undorground - safe from storm damage. Cables, howevor, run bencath many of the main thoroughfares and in consequence some have boen fractured by enomy bombs and ropaired.
