Dear Mr. Stenzel,

Many thanks for your letter of Nov. 15th with exchange list of Tertiary fossils. I found in it about 36 sp. which I would like to have.

According to your wishes I am enclosing a list of some of my duplicates, both recent (marine) & fossils (Paris Eocene) - I have many more sp. disponible, but I hope that you will find enough of interest in the present list (with its 136 items) to balance our exchange. May I suggest that you point out all of your desiderata from my list or at least more than you expect to receive, in case one sp. or the other should have become exhausted, which, however, is unlikely.

Since I possess many more sp. disponible (recent & fossil) & am keen on further exchanges, I would like to see other list of your spare material, not only from the Tertiary, but also recent (chiefly land & fresh water sp. & particularly from Texas, New Mexico, Arizona, S. Am. ... etc, since I already possess all the common marine forms & very many *Polygyra*, *Goniobasis*, etc from the more northern States) -
