AMEND ARTICLE I (Assembly Meetings) as follows:

Section 10: During the meeting and debate, no member shall engage in offensive remarks, profane language, personal attacks, or any disrespectful action announced by the Chair. Upon object by another member, the Chair shall decide if a remark or conduct constitutes offense and issue a warning.

AMEND ARTICLE II (Legislation) as follows:

D. No personal attacks shall be made by any person during the Assembly. If an attack is made by one person to another, that person shall lose debate privileges regarding the main and secondary motion on that topic. This shall count as one warning.
