Confirming Creel-Calhoun telecon May 14 Attorney General would be pleased accept invitation attend dedication memorial plaque and give memorial lecture at Free University on June 26.

Only possibility interference with visit would be Civil Rights difficulty of nature precluding Attorney General's departure from US for even short period.

To maintain political neutrality on German internal matters, Attorney General willing make brief stop at Bonn if Ambassador deems advisable. Embassy requested comment this possibility (with recommendation re preferred scheduling if appropriate).

~~Brandt will see Mayor Brandt before he departs.~~ We will inform Brandt of foregoing in Washington before he sees Attorney General. We expect use office meeting between Attorney General and Mayor Brandt, scheduled for 10:30 a.m. Eastern daylight time May 19, as opportunity issue press release covering proposed visit. Deadline should be firmly held. Will appreciate early receipt of proposals for text promised by USBER.
