I arived about 9 Days a go at St. Augustine and rent a confortable house out the town to the bay and have examined the surounding conutry also the Island- the flora is nearly the same like one latitude south of the Goulf of Mexico at Manetto & Sarasota strage to me to found this southern flora at the boruder of the Atlantic. Ouer progress in collecting the freshmater Molluskes was tollerably goodthe Saltilla River has one shells the U. Lecontianus, the St. Marys R. one smal shells- from the Trout crek near Kacksonville I collected a bouti shell and the Black crek has payd the visite very good, I collected about 6 to 7 Species we spend 22 day there. I take a great pleasure in sending you after my retourn from the southern trip a full collectinon of all the shell I have in my possesion and will collect on the southern tour. In about 2 Day I expect to start for Smyrne Lake Monrue L. The reason I have not answerd this pleasing lines was I expecting to visit florida some time a go, but it happenet to get of this spring to visite the Eastern part of florida. I arived a week a go at St. Augustine and examining the surounding country in Botany & Conchologie witch are about the same like Manette. We have here plenty fish & Austers, but a bad place for my horse -- I have rent a house hire and kept at this place my Depot in plants & shells-after 2 Days I expect to start for Smyrne, fort Mellon or Enterpreis and if every ding doing well I come to Tampa if I can travelle by Wagon there -- if there is a road to go to Manelte the home siccness would care my to your, but in this new country I tont can promiss any ding-- particularly at this travelling I have to go after circumstances, a fist  $\alpha$ plan will not stand.

I am very sorry for the melancholy end of your good brother Conf Brudon in the sugar bussiness I have no Doubt it will go mutch better after some years, after the secound and 3tr. crops, the sugar will granutate every years better with out trouble and you will shortly gat 2 hoshed to the itere and plenty Mollasse.

Suprarations fever hight. Nostril big of matter-Mouth and lip very incrusted. Eyes covern, smell offensive, pulse, very feeble-- water since 2 days red -- even colr zingal fouling trube 8. Unus circa 3 times a day says he hims no headache nor any pain in the bowel if profed -- but tells me he are to far gone to recovere, and got to mutch matter in his system.

In the Night from Wesdesday to Tuesday I go to bed from 10 to 12 octok the balance I tak care of the Dr. and Jones go to bed. He drinks wen aroused but can not transmit the slime of the trouth--made water, red wen cold sediment copious flacy-urina

craente.

[April] 23. he takes no attention what gos on around him -- the Pustulas are not advancing pulse very feeble. Drink some Arrowroot, Ataulated Syrup, but his strengt is visible failing, so as I have no hope to get him another night drought, I directed Mr. Johns to give him a injection if no operation some followed after several injections he rec. the Night and this morning--I promised to retourne as some as possible from me visites.

About passt 8 octok to Johnes. got out whit help and greath trouble Old Mr. Johnes fever incrising strenght feible, sleps

more, and calls evertime for drink or Medicines.

Missus improving gradually, apetite codrm, urinated freely, passage some impr.:

Miss Johnes improve slowly scaling sores on the legs dep. presing whitheratr down some inactive.

White and boy improving apetite very good--the 2 Johnes Son

and Doughty very advancing. Burrey improving.
Circa 10 oClok retour to Dr. Biddle slept no operation in bowel only & injection from 4 strenght sinking very fast, Drink not mutch, washt him the eyes, let his lady come to the window next the beid to see in spike a few last word whit him, but he could not bear the light of the day more. What a pitifull situation he ask me+= have you no simptom of Dying yet on me.

No Doctor -- After a little rest he dying to spik sends his advend to his friend Brother Temperance after having a mementary pain in the left lower parts of the bowel, he wished I bleed him, put I could not find any benefit of it, and made him camphorated linement, which had a good effect for rested about a hour ad & half and after 12 colok later told me lift me up, what we done I siting on one side and Jones on the onthre, but he could not hold up his head and we laid him bak, and imediately he expired whit out any strugle, soaft and pecefully. --

My hope not to loose one patiente was gone We laid him

after Diner out wash and rubt him in whit camphor oirl.

In the Evening to Johnes all improving, except aldr Johnesthe news of Biddles end got very close to all the sik. or johnes

turning his over in the bed fus very weak.

[April] 24. After Breckfast drest and put in the coffin carying on a pole whit great trouble at the hills top and give him the last service—the Lord give his soul the everlasting glory and his body rest.

After Diner go to Johnes .-- the old man sleping mostly

refuses medicines Drink, Soda Water.

[April]25. last Night good rest for me, I thakt the Lord

for my strength.

At Johnes the lad men visible sinking, the balance improving Keeping purgatives at antiphlogosis In the night I

got over till 12 ollok going bak.

[April] 26. At Johns all Doing well but the ald men coming close to his end. After super at my secound visit I stait over Wight expecting the exspiration of the old M. life after a Cute super I smoking a Degas and entered the house go to the bed and discovered Johnes dying gradualy. The old fellow not spiking his spirit was engaged but found no worth. He is gund not so easy as the Doctor as it stik me his faith in the Lord was not so fast as the Dr.
