APPRAISAL

AND

AN INTERESTING RELATIONSHIP IS DEVELOPING BETWEEN THE YUGOSLAVS 1. AND THE SOVIETS. THERE IS CORDIALITY DURING THEIR MEETINGS, BUT THERE IS NO GREAT WARMTH OR ENTHUSIASM. THE RELATIONSHIP ON THE PERSONAL LEVEL BETWEEN TITO AND KHRUSHCHEV IS CLOSER. WHEN TITO VISITED KHRUSHCHEV LAST WINTER, KHRUSHCHEV TOLD TITO THAT HE FULLY EXPECTED THE ECONOMIC CRISIS TO COME TO A HEAD AS IT DID RECENTLY. AT THE TIME THAT HE WAS NOT GOING TO BRING THE PREDICAMENT TO PUBLIC NOTICE UNTIL THE TIME WAS RIGHT TO EXPOSE IT. KHRUSHCHEV EVIDENTLY FELT THAT HE COULD ACT IN A HARD MANNER WHEN ALL THE FACTS WERE AVAILABLE FOR PRESENTATION AND WHEN HE HAD ALL OF HIS POLITICAL DEFENSES READY.

- D. YUGOSLAVIA REALLY FEARS THE INFLUENCE OF COMMUNIST CHINA IN THE "UNDERDEVELOPED WORLD OF ECONOMIC HAVE-NOTS" AND COLORED PEOPLES, FOR THE YUGOSLAVS ARE ABLE TO OBSERVE EVEN NOW IN AFRICA SOME TENDENCY FOR YUGOSLAVS, ALONG WITH ALL OTHER EUROPEANS AND THE AMERICANS, TO BE TREATED WITH RESERVE BECAUSE OF THEIR WHITE FACES.
- E. PRESIDENT TITO MAINLY WISHED TO BE REASSURED THAT
 THE UNITED STATES WAS NOT TRYING TO PROVOKE A BROAD MILITARY CONFLICT WITH COMMUNIST CHINA WHICH MIGHT RESULT SOMEHOW IN "BURNING
 THE WHOLE WORLD" WITH NUCLEAR WAR OR, AT LEAST, IN FORCING THE
 SOVIET UNION TO ADOPT A MORE HOSTILE ANTI-AMERICAN, ANTI-IMPERIALIST
 LINE, WHICH WOULD MAKE LIFE MORE DIFFICULT IN EASTERN EUROPE, PARTICULARLY FOR YUGOSLAVIA AND FOR "LIBERAL COMMUNIST" ELEMENTS IN
 THE SATELLITE COUNTRIES.
